Voter Registration

To vote in any election, including Water District elections, residents must be registered to vote in the county where they reside. In order to register to vote, you must be a U.S. citizen and 18 years of age. The voter registration application must be received in the voter registrar's office or postmarked 30 days before an election for you to be eligible to vote in that election.

Candidate Information

Orange County Water Control & Improvement District is governed by a Board of Directors that consists of Five Directors who are elected at-large by majority vote.

Each candidate for an elective office shall meet the following qualifications: (as specified in Section 51.072 of the Texas Water Code)

- be a resident of the state;
- own land subject to taxation in the District;
- be a qualified voter of the District;
- be at least 18 years of age;
